**RESOLUTION TO SEPARATE THE TAX AND LICENSE DEPARTMENT  
FROM THE TREASURER'S DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Tax and License Department, during the re-engineering phase in 2005, was combined with the Treasurer's Department and has been operating under the supervision and control of the City's Treasurer's Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Treasurer's Department consist of a Treasurer, who is the Department Head of the Department, a Tax Collector, and adequate staff for the faithful performance of their duties and the safe custody of the City funds. The Treasurer is the custodian of the funds of the municipality, keeping an accurate record of the funds of the several departments and the Tax Collector is responsible for the collection of all city taxes and all public improvement assessments; and

**WHEREAS**, it would be in the best interest of the City for the Selma City Council to separate the Departments whereby the Tax and License Department would operate and function as an independent Department with a Department Head and staff, as was the case prior to the re-engineering phase in 2005.

**WHEREAS**, the Tax and License Department shall consist of a Tax Collector, who shall be classified as the Department Head of the Department and shall have under his/her supervision adequate staff for the collection of all city taxes and all public improvement assessments; and


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF SELMA AS FOLLOWS:**

That the Tax and License Department shall be separated from the Treasurer's Department and shall operate as a Department consisting of a Tax Collector, who shall be classified as the Department Head of the Department and shall have under his/her supervision adequate staff for the collection of all city taxes and all public improvement assessments; and

Said resolution shall rescind and repeal all previous actions, resolutions and other laws that shall or would be in conflict with this resolution.
