SPECIAL USE PERMIT FOR MODIFICATION OF A
WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS FACILITY

Verizon 5339 Alabama Highway 22
Selma, Alabama

WHEREAS, Verizon Wireless has requested to modify an existing telecommunication tower located at 5339 AL Highway 22, Selma AL to provide wireless services essentially within the corporate limits and police jurisdiction of the City of Selma; and

WHEREAS, Verizon Wireless has complied with the City's Ordinance No. COS 013-00/01 and has demonstrated the need for a wireless facility to consistently deliver reliable services in the identified area; and

WHEREAS, the City's consultant, The Center for Municipal Solutions (CMS) recommends the granting of a Special Use Permit for this facility located at 5339 AL Highway 22 which consists of an existing 286' guyed tower.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Selma, AL that Verizon Wireless is hereby granted a Special Use Permit to modify the existing tower located at 5339 AL Highway 22. As recommended by CMS, the Special Use Permit is subject to compliance with the following conditions prior to the issuance of said permit and/or a Certificate of Completion:

1. Verizon Wireless must provide a passing Structural Analysis after completion of modifications to the tower and prior to installation of additional antennas/coax.
2. Contractor information must be provided to both City and CMS prior to issuance of the Building Permit for the tower modifications. Contractor must notify the City's consultant for inspection of the modifications.
3. Once Verizon Wireless has met all the conditions of the Building Permit for the modifications, a Building Permit will be issued for the installation of the antennas/coax.
4. At the completion of construction, Verizon Wireless must notify the City's consultant and provide proof that all inspections have been satisfactorily completed and the project is ready for a final on-site inspection. Upon passing the final inspection, a recommendation to issue a Certificate of Occupancy shall be made.
5. Verizon Wireless shall not be permitted to actually provide service commercially until the Certificate of Occupancy or its functional equivalent is issued or risk forfeiting its Permit.
6. The Certificate of Occupancy shall not be issued until all fees and costs associated with this Permit, including inspections, have been paid.
